ADVISORY ON THE EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS TO THE PHILIPPINES RELATIVE TO THE NEW SARS-CoV-2 VARIANTS

The Philippine Consulate General in Chicago wishes to inform the public that pursuant to the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Disease (IATF-MEID) Resolution No. 94 dated 14 January 2021, the temporary entry restrictions to the Philippines due to the new SARS-CoV-2 variants is hereby **EXTENDED** until 31 January 2021.

Foreign passengers coming from the countries/jurisdictions listed above, or who have been to said countries/jurisdictions within 14 days immediately preceding arrival in the Philippines, shall be prohibited from entering the country until 31 January 2021.

The Philippine Bureau of Immigration (BI) reminds all arriving Filipino nationals in the Philippines that it will continue to implement current existing entry and health protocols contained in previous advisories released by the Consulate.
