PUBLIC ADVISORY NO. 18-2021

NEW TESTING AND QUARANTINE PROTOCOLS FOR ALL ARRIVING INTERNATIONAL PASSENGERS IN THE PHILIPPINES

The Philippine Consulate General in Chicago wishes to inform the public that, pursuant to Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-MEID) Resolution No. 114 Series of 2021 dated 06 May 2021, effective 08 May 2021, all arriving international passengers in the Philippines shall be subject to the following:

1. Mandatory quarantine for fourteen (14) days. The first ten (10) days of which shall be observed in a hotel or a quarantine facility.
2. Reverse Transcription Polymerase Chain Reaction (RT-PCR) testing shall be conducted on the seventh (7th) day with Day 1 being the day of arrival/check-in.
3. Arriving passengers may continue their quarantine at home or in their hotels (as the case may be) from Day 11 up to Day 14, provided they get a negative RT-PCR test result. **END**
