### PHILIPPINE CONSULATE GENERAL IN CHICAGO HOSTS A WEBINAR ON ANTI ASIAN HATE CRIMES



02 JUNE 2020 (CHICAGO) – The Philippine Consulate General in Chicago hosted a webinar on Anti-Asian Hate Crimes on 24 May 2021 to bring awareness to the Filipino and Filipino-American in the Midwest especially those residing in the City of Chicago.
