## PH CONSULATE GENERAL IN CHICAGO HOLDS CONSULAR OUTREACH IN MICHIGAN

*31 August 2021, Chicago – In collaboration with the Philippine American Community Center in Michigan (PACCM) and the Philippine Honorary Consulate General in Michigan, the Consulate General held a consular outreach for passport and dual citizenship services at PACCM, 17356 Northland Park Ct, Southfield, MI 48075 on 28 August 2021.*

The outreach team, headed by Consul Melvin Almonguera, provided a total of 250 consular services to Filipinos and Filipino-Americans who are based in Michigan during the one-day event.
