Philippines Extends Visa-Free Entry for 151 countries from 21 to 30 days

In line with the Philippine Government's efforts to further encourage tourism in the Philippines, the Consulate General is pleased to announce that the visa-free privilege granted to 151 countries under Executive Order 408 shall be extended from twenty-one (21) days to thirty-days (30), effective immediately.

The following requirements for visa-free entry to the Philippines are:

1. A national passport valid for at least six (6) months beyond the contemplated stay; and
2. A return ticket to the country of origin or onward ticket to the next country of destination.

NO-VISA ENTRY FOR 30-DAYS STAY UNDER E.O. 408

Countries whose nationals may enter the Philippines without a visa for a stay not exceeding thirty (30) days under E.O. 408, provided these foreign nationals are holders of a passport valid at least six (6) months, beyond the period of stay in the Philippines and return or outward bound tickets to: country of origin or next country of destination.
