Chicago, 13 April 2018 – The Philippine Consulate General in Chicago looks to increase the level of its engagement with the State of Illinois by collaborating with the Attorney General's Office.

Ms. Nettie Leon Lasko, Senior Government and Community Relations Officer of the Office of the Attorney General, called on Consul General Gina A. Jamoralin and discussed the various programs their office conducts for various communities in Illinois where the Consulate General can participate in and promote for the benefit of the Filipino community.
