PMAC PRESIDENT CALLS ON PHILIPPINE CONSUL GENERAL

Chicago, 23 April 2018 – To bolster ties and cooperation with the Filipino-American community in the Midwest, Consul General Gina A. Jamoralin today met with Dr. Natividad P. Bernardino, President of the Philippine Medical Association in Chicago (PMAC).

The Consul General personally expressed her sympathies over the loss of seven PMAC members due to a tragic vehicular accident in Cebu early this year, just days prior to their scheduled medical and surgical mission to the island province of Camiguin.

They discussed opportunities where PMAC and the Consulate General can work together to promote and preserve Filipino culture and tradition among the millennial generation of Filipino-Americans through the upcoming Ambassadors' Tour in July and possible exposure or immersion programs and art exhibits in the future.

Generating interest and active involvement among second or third generation Filipino-Americans to carry on humanitarian and cultural endeavors is recognized as one of the priorities the PMAC and Consulate General can work on together. **END**
