**Consul General Gina A. Jamoralin Meets the Press During  
the 2018 Asia Business Summit in Kansas City**

With the Consuls General of China, India, Indonesia, Pakistan, Turkey, and Bangladesh's Commercial Counselor, Consul General Gina A. Jamoralin participated in the Business Summit's "face the press" event in the morning of 11 May 2018—during which the Consuls General were asked by the members of the local and national press about their view on the Summit, and specific issues about the opportunities and challenges that confront trade and investments in the region (Asia Pacific) and in their respective countries.

Consul General Jamoralin informed the members of the media of the Philippines' sound economic fundamentals and the "*Build-Build-Build*" investment-complementing infrastructure projects of the current administration. The Consul General also discussed the Philippines' competitive edge in the areas of human resources (e.g., young, talented and abundant workforce pool) and highly flexible investment incentives arrangements. Further, the undersigned gave a short account of the anti-corruption measures that the Philippines have institutionalized, especially in the processing of business licenses and documents.

Consul General Jamoralin was in Kansas on 09-12 May 2018 to participate in the 2018 Asia Business Summit and MAACA Cultural Festival.
