PHL CONSULATE GENERAL IN CHICAGO SURPASSES TARGET FOR OVERSEAS VOTERS' REGISTRATION

Chicago, 23 May 2018 – The Philippine Consulate General in Chicago has reported to the Department of Foreign Affairs that it has already surpassed the target number of 8,588 new registrants for Overseas Voting.

“Having reached 100 percent of our target more than four months before the deadline is an accomplishment we owe to the excellent teamwork of our staff and support from Manila, especially the Overseas Voting Secretariat,” said Consul General Gina A. Jamoralin.

The Consulate General continues its call for more eligible Filipinos in the Midwest to list up for Overseas Voting until 30 September 2018, so they can exercise their right to participate in national elections and shape the country's future.
