Ms. Nettie Lasko, Immigrant Assistance Program Coordinator and Government and Community Relations Officer, discussed various programs and services provided by the Office of the Attorney General, such as consumer protection, identity theft hotline, student loan help, public utilities and crime victim services.

In her presentation, Ms. Lasko reiterated Attorney General Kwame Raoul's commitment to advance and protect the public interests of its residents by enforcing state laws and working with the members of the Illinois General Assembly to enact new laws.
