PHILIPPINE CONSULATE HOLDS SUCCESSFUL CONSULAR OUTREACH IN WICHITA, KANSAS

7 August 2019 Chicago – The Philippine Consulate General in Chicago, in partnership with the Filipino American Association of Greater Wichita (FAAGW), extended its consular services to 221 clients during an outreach in Wichita, Kansas on 3 August 2019.

The outreach, which was held at the Hampton Inn and Suites, provided e-passport, civil registration, and notarization and authentication services to 200 members of the Filipino-American community. The Consulate also processed 21 applications for dual citizenship.

Led by FAAGW President Rose Axman, the organization's leaders and members served as volunteers, ensuring the smooth and orderly conduct of operations and logistical activities. Clients, who came from all over Kansas and neighboring states, expressed appreciation for the timely and responsive services provided by the Consulate with the support of FAAGW.
